A RUTLAND building has made it through to the finals of a prestigious regional competition.

The Olive Branch and Beech House in Clipsham, Rutland, has been nominated in both the Regeneration Award and the Building Conservation Award in the East Midlands heat of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors awards.
